HEALTH TALK

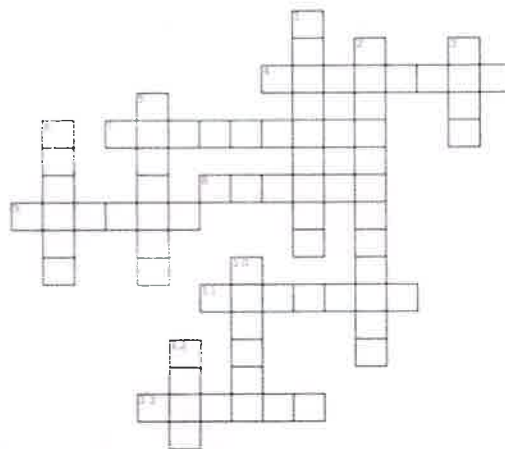
Have you or someone you know ever had cataract surgery? Did it seem like the surgery didn't work after? Some people develop scar tissue after which can make it difficult to see, but there is an answer!

The scar tissue (also known as a secondary cataract) can occur almost immediately after the surgery, or months to years later. The buildup of this scar tissue is part of the normal healing response of the eye, and once cleared away with the laser, it will never return.

YAG Laser Capsulotomy is a special laser treatment used to further improve your vision after cataract surgery when a form of scar tissue forms behind the intraocular lens. It is a simple, commonly performed, out-patient procedure which is very safe and only takes a few minutes.

So consult your doctor if you think this may be the issue after your cataract surgery!
